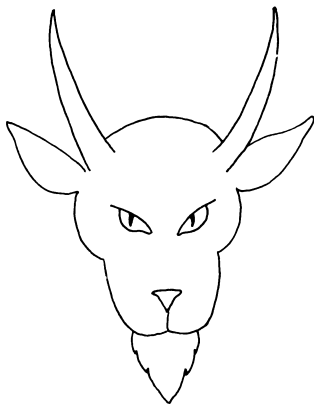


THE DEVIL RIDES IN



Operating Instructions

LOADING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Connect the EAR socket on your Spectrum to the EAR socket on your cassette recorder, and ensure that the MIC lead is completely disconnected.
2. Type LOAD " " and press the ENTER key on your Spectrum.
3. Press play on the cassette recorder, checking that the volume and tone controls are set to approximately $\frac{3}{4}$ maximum.
4. The Devil Rides In will now load in several parts.

CONTROLS

KEY A or KEY 5	MOVES YOUR PLAYER LEFT
KEY L or KEY 8	MOVES YOUR PLAYER RIGHT
KEY X or KEY 6	MOVES YOUR PLAYER DOWN
KEY M or KEY 7	MOVES YOUR PLAYER UP
SPACE KEY OR KEY 0 (ZERO)	SHOOTS BEAM FROM TALISMAN
CAPSSHIFT OR KEY 9	MOVES TALISMAN THROUGH EIGHT DIRECTIONS.

JOYSTICK: "The Devil Rides In" is designed for playing with the Spectrum Keyboard or with the use of the following Joystick interfaces:

AGF JOYSTICK INTERFACE II

You are a Wizard in battle with the legions of hell. Your defence's consist of a magic circle, which you cannot leave and whose boundaries you must not touch, and a talisman that has the power to destroy the hellish army.

SCREEN 1: Features ghostly figures that hurtle deadly projectiles into your circle. Use your talisman to destroy the ghosts and make way for - - - - -

SCREEN 2: Attack of the Giant Spiders. Large Spiders, firing deadly projectiles, creep ever closer to your circle. Little spiders scurry around your circle building a web to protect the large Spiders from your talismans rays.

SCREEN 3: Feature little devils who scurry around your circle. They are not dangerous until you strike them with the beam from your talisman. Skeletons occasionally appear and drift in to steal parts of your circle.

SCREEN 4 The Angel of Death appears astride a winged stallion. Hit the **rider** three times and he will disintegrate and reform again for another attack.
AND 6:

SCREEN 5: Features the winged Demons and the skeletons. It will take two direct hits from your talisman to destroy the winged demons.
