LOADING INSTRUCTIONS

Load the game "Mercenary - Escape From Targ" as usual. This load must be completed and the opening sequence (culminating in the crash landing on Targ) must have occurred before loading this dataset.

Place your Second City cassette in recorder and rewind fully.

Press (CAPS SHIFT) and 'L' simultaneously.

Benson Response: PRESS RETURN WHEN READY

Press Play on cassette recorder and then,

Press (ENTER) for the Second City Dataset to load.

(Press any other key to abort the load.)

NOTE: SAVES FROM 'ESCAPE FROM TARG' AND 'THE SECOND CITY' WILL NOT LOAD AND PLAY ONE FROM THE OTHER.

LOAD ERROR

If the computer detects that the dataset is not loading satisfactorily, either Benson will message **TAPE ERROR** or the screen border colour will become **RED**. In this event, re-wind cassette, press the (**SPACE KEY**) and then press Play on cassette to re-try the load.

A common reason for such a failure is an inappropriate cassette volume setting. Proceed by trial and error to establish a suitable setting. If continuous problems occur, check the recorders azimuth setting.
