

This cassette contains two programs; Old MacDonald's Farm and S.O.R.T. recorded in this order on side A and in the reverse order on side B.

You can avoid long waits by choosing which side of the tape to use. If you have a tape counter on your tape player you can use it easily to locate the programs on each side of the tape, if you note the reading at the start of that program, having first set the counter to zero at the tape start.

## Loading the Games

### To load Old MacDonald's Farm:

- type LOAD " M A C " and press ENTER
- press PLAY on the cassette player

The on-screen instruction STOP THE TAPE will tell you when loading is complete.

#### To load S.O.R.T:

- type LOAD "SORT" and press ENTER
- press PLAY on the cassette player

The on-screen instruction STOP THE TAPE will tell you when loading is complete.

If the next program on the tape is the one you require, it is sufficient to type LOAD " instead of the program title.

Do not press CAPS/SHIFT and BREAK together at any time as the program will crash and you will have to reload.

## **Playing the Games**

On loading **Old MacDonald's Farm** you will be presented with a choice of three games; Memory, Odd-one-Out and Snap. Choose your game by pressing the key number indicated.

A second menu page will appear. This offers a choice of two difficulty levels and the option to see instructions. In Snap you can also choose whether to play a one or two-player game. During play you may leave any game and return to the first menu by holding down  $\overline{\text{CAPS/SHIFT}}$  and  $\overline{\text{Z}}$  together.

**S.O.R.T.** starts with an introduction page setting the scene for the tests which follow. The menu which follows offers the choice of practising any of the three S.O.R.T. tests, or of taking the full test. Each individual test is preceded by brief on-screen instructions. At the start of the full test the player must enter his or her name. At the end of the full S.O.R.T., the player's score is recorded on a top-score table, setting a challenge for other family members. Holding down  $\boxed{\text{CAPS/SHIFT}}$  and  $\boxed{\textbf{Z}}$  together will return you to the start of the program at any point during the tests.

# Have you got problems loading the program?

- 1. Have you remembered to press ENTER?
- 2. Has the cassette been fully re-wound?
- Are your tape recorder leads connected properly? Refer to your computer's user manual.
- 4. Check the volume level of your cassette recorder. Is it correct?
- 5. Please check that you have followed all equipment and loading instructions very carefully.
