SPECTRUM ADDENDUM

Loading Instructions

SPECTRUM 48/128K. +2 CASSETTE

Type **LOAD** and press **ENTER**.

Then press **PLAY** on your cassette recorder and follow screen prompts.

SPECTRUM +3 DISK

Turn on Computer, insert disk into drive and then press **ENTER**. Follow on screen prompts.

WINTER GAMES™

A menu screen offers you a choice of options. To make a selection, use the **SPACE KEY** to move the cursor to your choice, then press **ENTER**.

OPTION 1: COMPETE IN ALL EVENTS

The Computer keeps a running tally of medals awarded to each player.

- To enter your name, type your name on the keyboard and press **ENTER**.
- Repeat name selection for each additional player (up to four). When all players' names are entered, press **ENTER**.

OPTION 2: COMPETE IN ONE EVENT

Similar to OPTION 1, but you only compete in the event you select. Use the **SPACE KEY** to choose the event, then press **ENTER**.

OPTION 3: PRACTICE ONE EVENT

No scores are kept during practice rounds. Use the **SPACE KEY** to choose the event, then press **ENTER**.

OPTION 4: JOYSTICKS

If a one player game is selected the player may use any joystick. If two or more players wish to play then they cannot select the joystick interface. Each player must select a different interface. Any number of players can select to use the keyboard.

OPTION 5: SEE WORLD RECORDS

Displays the highest score recorded in all events, with the name of the player who achieved each world record. Press **FIRE** to return to the menu.

Important: Due to programming limitations there are no **OPENING/CLOSING** ceremonies.

STARTING PLAY

When **WORLD GAMES** has loaded you will be presented with a menu screen. **THE WORLD GAMES** menu offers a choice of four options for practising or competing in events. To make a selection use **UP** and **DOWN** to move to one of the options and press **FIRE**.

OPTION 1: PLAY ALL EVENTS

Play all events: Weight Lifting, Barrel Jumping, Cliff Driving, Slalom Skiing, Log Rolling, Caber Toss and Sumo Wrestling. The Computer tallies the number of medals awarded to each player as you compete.

- To enter your name, type your name on the keyboard and press **ENTER**.
- Repeat the name selection for each additional player (up to four). When all players' names are entered press **RETURN**.
- A verification screen appears. If all names are correct, select **YES** with the **UP** and **DOWN** keys then press **FIRE**. If you need to make changes select **NO**.

OPTION 2: PLAY SOME EVENTS

Similar to OPTION 1 but you compete only in the events you select.

- Select the event(s) by moving **UP** and **DOWN** and pressing **FIRE**.

- The events you select will be displayed in white.
- Once you have finished selecting events, move the cursor to the word **DONE** and press **FIRE**.

OPTION 3: PLAY ONE EVENT

Similar to OPTIONS 1 and 2, but you compete only in the event you select.

- Use **UP** and **DOWN** to choose the event, then press **FIRE**.

OPTION 4: PRACTICE ONE EVENT

- Use **UP** and **DOWN** to choose the event, then press **FIRE**.

Note: Scoring is not kept during practice rounds.

Q – UP
O – LEFT
A – DOWN
P – RIGHT

UP – Forward

DOWN – Back

SPACE – Fire

PRACTICE PLAY

(Disk versions only)

To practice an event use the joystick to move the torch to the appropriate game event icon on the village map. Press **FIRE** to practice that event. After completing the practice round, you'll be asked if you want to play the event again. Select **YES** and press **FIRE** to return to the same event. Selecting **NO** and pressing the **FIRE** will return you to the village map.

PRACTICE IN ALL EVENTS

Select this option to practice each of the eight events in turn. After playing each event you will have the option to practice again or continue to the next event.

CHANGE CONTROL

This option allows you to change the keys or joysticks used for both players 1 and 2 enabling direct competitive play. Both players may use the same controls, but when competing in the Velodrome Cycling or Hurdles events, each player will have to play against a computer pacer rather than each other.
